

Chapter 17.

Granting the right of way to The O. & C. R.R. Co
over and along Broad Albin Street

The City of Albany does ordain as follows

Sec 1st The Oregon and California Rail Road Company of Portland Oregon is hereby authorized and permitted to lay a Railway track and run Cars over the same along Elsworth Street to Eighth Street thence along Eighth Street to Broad Albin Street thence down Broad Albin Street to Water Street, also the right of Way up Water Street as hereinafter provided

Sec 2nd The said Rail Road Company shall grade & establish, construct and maintain in good repair said Street at least six (6) feet in width upon each side of the center line of said Street and as much wider as may be affected by said Rail Way or the construction thereof and shall do and perform said work and the improvements and repairs thereof in such manner and as often as the Common Council of the City of Albany may at any time provide for or require

Sec 3rd The Common Council reserve the right to make or to alter regulations at any time, as they deem proper for the conduct of said Road within the limits of the City, and the speed of Rail way Cars and locomotives, within said limits, and may restrict or prohibit the running of Locomotives at such times and in such manner as they may deem necessary.

Sec 4th All alterations of grades on Streets required for laying said Rail Road track and all improvements and repairs of the same for said purpose shall be at the expense of the said Rail Road Company as may be provided by Ordinance

Sec 5th It is hereby expressly provided that any refusal or neglect of said Oregon and California Rail Road

Company to comply with the provisions and requirements of this ordinance or any other ordinance passed in pursuance hereof shall be deemed a forfeiture of the rights and privileges herein granted and it shall be lawful for the Common Council to declare by Ordinance the forfeiture of the same and to cause the said rail way to be removed from the street

No 2 Charter 18th

Repealing Sect 1st Title 1st Chapter 5th City Laws Albany Jan 24th 1871

The City of Albany does hereby Ordain as follows That Section first under title first of Chapter fifth of the City laws of Albany shall be so amended as to read as follows

"If not otherwise provided for by the City Council the side walks shall be six feet wide south of first Street &c
