

City Ordinance No 9 Entitled  
"An Ordinance to grade Jefferson Street"

The City of Albany does ordain as follows.

- Sect 1<sup>st</sup> That the owners of lots upon Jefferson Street between Water Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Albany be and they are hereby required at their own expense under the supervision of the committee on streets and public property to grade and ~~grade~~ said street as hereinafter denoted in front of their respective lot or lots
- Sect 2 That the grade on said street shall be determined by said committee on streets and public property with or without the aid of a surveyor as said committee shall deem best
- Sect 3 The grading on said street shall be done by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June 1871
- Sect 4 That in case the owner of any lot or lots on said street shall neglect or refuse to grade said street in front of their respective lots as required by this Ordinance then it shall be the duty of the City Marshal to cause the same to be done at as little expense as practicable and to collect the expense of such grading from the owner of said property by an action before the recorder of said City.
- Sect 5 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after five days from the date of its passage
