

City Ordinance No 10, Entitled, "An Ordinance to grade and gravel a portion of first Street"

The City of Albany does ordain as follows

Sec 1st That the owners of lots upon first Street between Jefferson Street and Montgomery Street in the City of Albany be and they are hereby required at their own expense under the supervision of the committee on Streets and public property, to grade and gravel said Street as hereinafter directed in front of their respective lot or lots.

Sec 2nd That the grade on said Street shall be determined by said committee on Streets and public property with or without the aid of a surveyor as said committee shall deem best

Sec 3rd That said Street shall be graded to the width of twenty feet ten feet on each side of the center line thereof and to the depth of not less than four inches. The gravel to be used to be as clear of dirt sand or debris as ever reasonably be obtained

Sec 4th That all necessary grading shall be done on or before the 15th day of June 1871 and the graveling done before the first day of August 1871

Sec 5th That in case the owner of any lot or lots on said Street shall neglect, fail or refuse to grade or gravel in front of their respective lots as by this ordinance required then it shall be the duty of the City Marshal to cause the same to be done at as little expense as practicable and to collect such expense of grading and graveling from the owner of such property by an action upon the records of said City

City Ordinance No 10 continue

Sec 6 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after five days from the date of its passage

City Ordinance No 11 Entitled
"An Ordinance to grade & gravel a portion of Water Street and a portion of Jackson Street"

The City of Albany does Ordain as follows

Sec 1st That the owners of lots upon Jackson Street between Second Street and Water Street, and upon Water Street between Jackson Street and Jefferson Street in the City of Albany be and they are hereby required at their own expense under the supervision of the "Committee on Streets and Public Property" to grade and gravel said streets as herein after directed in front of their respective lot or lots.

Sec 2 That the grade on said Street shall be determined with or without the aid of a surveyor as said Committee shall deem best

Sec 3 That said Street shall be graded to the width of twenty feet taper on each side of the center line thereof and to the depth of not less than four inches the gravel to be used to be as clear of dirt sand and debris as can reasonably be obtained
