

Ordinance No 35

An Ordinance to provide for the purchase of Hose and appurtenances and a Hose Cart to be used by Linn Engine Company No 2 and to pay insurance freight and charges thereon!

Be it ordained by The Common Council of the City of Albany!

Sec 1 That there be and hereby is appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of One Thousand Dollars or so much thereof as is necessary to pay for one Clapp & Jones Hose Cart and five hundred feet of good fire engine hose with the necessary Couplings and Nozzles to fully equip a No 4 Clapp and Jones Steam fire Engine for actual service, and to pay freight insurance and charges on the same

Sec 2 That whenever Linn Engine Company No 2 shall officially notify in writing the City Recorder of the City of Albany that said Linn Engine Company No 2 is provided with the funds and ready to forward the same for the purchase of a Steam fire Engine that he be and hereby is required to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the City of Albany for the sum of One Thousand Dollars in United States Gold Coin in favor of G. W. Gray W W P Cash

and J. K. Weatherford as provided for in section one of this Ordinance and that the said G. W. Gray Will Parish and J. K. Weatherford be authorized and required to remit the same for the purposes aforesaid with or as near as may be at the time said Lion Engine Company No 2 remits the funds to pay for said Steam Fire Engine: provided, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to give said Lion Engine Co No 2 any right of property in said Hose Cart, Hose appurtenances or any part thereof. And provided further that said Lion Engine Company No 2 shall have the exclusive use of said Hose Cart, Hose and appurtenances for the extinguishment of fire and drill practice.

Sec 3 } That any money of the aforesaid appropriation of One Thousand Dollars remaining unexpended after purchasing the Hose Cart Hose Couplings connections Nozzles and appurtenances and paying freight charges and insurance on the same as provided for by section one of this Ordinance shall be paid by said Lion Engine Company to the Credit of the City of Albany as part payment of the current expenses of running said Steam Engine
