

Ordinance No - 60

An ordinance to provide for securing for the City of Albany the use of a steam fire engine and to appropriate money therefor

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany

Sec 1

That there be and hereby is appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars in United States Gold Coin to the Lion Engine Co. No 2 as payment in advance for two years for the use of and benefit derived from said Steam Fire Engine from and after the same is received and housed in working order in the City of Albany provided that said Steam Fire Engine together with the hose and hose cart to be used therewith are to remain in the possession of and operated by said Lion Engine Co. No Two and provided further that said Lion Engine Co. No Two shall before calling for the appropriation of money herein provided for through its proper officers file with the City Recorder of the City of Albany a writing avowing it to be admitted as a competent part of the fire department of said City of Albany and therein promising a strict compliance with its

Sec 2

Whenever the written petition
named in section one of the
Ordinance is filed with the City
Recorder of said City of Albany
it is hereby made his duty to draw
his warrant on the Treasurer of
the City of Albany in favor of
J. K. Weatherford Secretary and W. W.
Parish Treasurer and their succe-
ssors in office of Lion Engine
Co No 2 for the sum of One
Thousand Dollars in Gold Coin
as provided for in section one
of this Ordinance

Sec 3

That the City of Albany have the
privilege at any time, hereafter
of buying the aforesaid Steam Engine
at that cost of the same when
housed in said City of Albany
and that the sum of One Thousand
Dollars appropriated by Sec one
and two of this Ordinance shall
upon the consummation of ^{such} this sale
be regarded as a part of the purchase
price thereof and that the acceptance
of the foregoing appropriation by
Lion Engine Company No 2 shall
be construed to be an agreement
of said Lion Engine Co No 2
to the sale and transfer to the
City of Albany of said Steam Engine
on the aforesaid terms and
conditions and upon the

Further condition that said
Steam Engine shall be allotted
to said Lion Engine Co. & Co.
so long as it remains an
organized Company and complies
with the rules and usages of
the fire department of said City
