

Ordinance No. 68.

An Ordinance for Licensing Hotel keepers

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany
Linn County Oregon

Section 1. Hotel keepers shall pay a quarterly license of two dollars. Every person who, on the ^{public} streets of Albany or on the wharves, or at the Rail Road depot, shall in a public manner, solicit custom for any hotel inn or tavern or boarding house shall be deemed a hotel keeper under this Ordinance. Any person who shall violate the foregoing Ordinance shall on conviction thereof before the Recorder for every such offense be liable to the payment of the license, be subject to a fine not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars or imprisonment not less than five nor more than thirty days.
