

+ + Ordinance No 83

An Ordinance To Authorize the laying of Water Mains and pipes in all Streets and Alleys of the City of Albany.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany Orgn.

Sec. 1st. That James H Foster and J A Comford of Whiter and assigns be and are hereby granted the right and privilege of laying pipes through ~~the~~ all the Streets and Alleys of the City of Albany, for the purpose of conducting water through the City by means thereof and supply the City and its inhabitants with water.

Sec 2 That the ditche for laying said pipes shall be seven feet and a half, and the pipes conducting the water shall be under the surface or level of the established grade of the Street (where a grade is established) at least two feet and that no pipes shall be laid so as to interfere with the erecting of Corns.

Sec 3 The work of digging such ditche for laying or repairing of said pipes when laid through the Streets or alleys of this City shall be done under the inspection of the Street Commissioner and completed as soon as practicable. And the Streets or Alleys through which the Corn may be dug shall without delay be put in

as good ~~as~~ condition as they
 were before such ditch or ditches
 were dug through the dam, and all
 displaced sand, earth, rubbish or
 other material caused or made by
 the digging of such ditches or
 laying down pipes or repairing
 the same shall be removed from
 such ditches or ditches by the said
 J. H. Hastings of Albarrford of Wharfedale
 this assigned without delay.

Sec 4 Nothing in this ordinance
 shall be so construed as to grant
 an exclusive right or privilege
 to the said J. H. Hastings of Albarrford
 of Wharfedale assigned of condu-
 cting water into or through the
 City for its use or the use of
 its inhabitants.
