Ordinance No 92

An Ordinance to provide for building, repairing and alley, crosswalks and keeping the same repaired

Enacted and Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany,

Sec 1 All owners of lots or parts of lots within the City limits shall be required to build and keep repaired, the sidewalks and Alley Crosswalks adjoining their respective lot or lots; the expense of building the Alley Crosswalks shall be equally divided between the property owners adjacent thereto extending to the center of the block on each side of the Alley

Sec 2 Whenever the City Council shall order a sidewalk or Alley Crosswalk to be built adjoining any lot or lots within the City limits the Marshal shall notify the owner, occupant or agent of said lot or lots in writing particularly describing the improvements to be made and the time within which the same is to be done, and if the owner or owner thereof neglect or refuse to build the same within the time specified in said notice then it shall be the duty of the Marshal to build or cause the same to be built and the expense of building said sidewalk or alley crosswalk shall be taxed up against the property and action taken thereon in the same manner as provided for in Ordinance no 88 relating to the recording and foreclosure of liens

Sec 3 The Marshal shall from time to time inspect the sidewalks and alley crosswalks of the City and when any are found to be in bad condition it shall be his duty to immediately notify the owner, occupant or agent of the property adjacent thereto (in writing particularly describing the improvements or repairs to be made) to make the necessary repairs within ten (10) days from date of said notice and if they fail to do so within



That time, it shall then be the duty of the Marshal to do said work himself or cause the same to be done and the costs shall be taxed up against the said property and a lien recorded, and action taken thereon in the same manner as provided for in Ordinance no 88 relating to the mending and foreclosure of liens

Sec 4 The Marshal shall receive for his services for all work done under this Ordinance such compensation as the Council may deem reasonable and just

Sec 5 All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed

Sec 6 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and five days after its publication
