

Ordinance No. 112.

An Ordinance to amend section 7 of an Ordinance entitled "Ordinance No. 46 regulating the Fire Department of the City of Albany, passed February 19th 1878.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany,

Section 7. That section seven(7) of ordinance No. 46 regulating the Fire Department of the City of Albany, passed February 19th 1878, be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 7. Each steam engine company shall be allowed for ordinary expenses of company and apparatus the sum of \$100.00 per quarter; each hand engine company shall be allowed \$300.00 per quarter; each hose and ladder company shall be allowed \$300.00 per quarter; each independent hose company shall be allowed \$15.00 per quarter; and the Board of Delegates shall be allowed \$50.00 per quarter.

Section 8. That this ordinance take effect from and after five days after its publication.
