

Ordinance no 152

An Ordinance relating to the obstruction of streets, sidewalks, and
crosswalks.

The People of the City of Albany, do ordain as follows:

Section 1 Any person or persons who shall stand in or upon the street, sidewalks
or crosswalks within the limits of the City of Albany, after being notified
to move on by any police officer of said City, shall upon conviction
before the Recorder of the City of Albany, be punished by a fine not
exceeding ten dollars, or imprisonment not more than five days.

Section 11 This Ordinance to be in force from and after five days after its publication.
