

Ordinance No 160.

An Ordinance defining and prescribing the Qualification and duties of the City Marshal.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. Before entering upon the discharge of the duties of his office, the City Marshal shall file with the City Recorder a certificate with his oath of office as prescribed by the City Charter endorsed thereon, and also a bond payable to the City of Albany in such sum as the City Council may require, payable in gold coin of the United States, with two or more sureties who justify in like manner as bail upon arrest under the laws of the State of Oregon and to be approved by the Mayor, conditioned that he will honestly and faithfully discharge his duties as City Marshal, account for and pay over to the City Treasurer all money that comes into his hands by virtue of his office, and turn over to his successor in office all books, papers and property belonging to the City of Albany, that may come into his hands by virtue of his office as City Marshal and that he will faithfully and impartially perform all duties that may be required of him by the City Council.

Section 2. The City Marshal shall be a Conservator of the peace, and shall execute all processes directed to him by the Recorder of said City, or by any magistrate

of the state of Oregon. He shall attend regularly upon the sitting of the Recorder's Court. He may make arrests for a breach of the peace, for a violation of any City ordinance or for the commission of crime within the city limits, the same as a peace officer may under the laws of this state. He shall collect all taxes levied by the City Council as required by ordinance, and shall immediately pay over all money so collected by him to the City Treasurer, taking therefore duplicate receipts, one of which shall be filed in the Recorder's Office and placed to his credit. When any person doing business within the City, or engaging in any occupation for which a City license is required shall neglect or refuse to take out a license as required by the City ordinance, it shall be the duty of the City Marshal to inform against and prosecute such person before the City Recorder, and enforce the payment of such license fee from such delinquent, and in the discharge of his duties he shall exercise a vigilant control over the peace and best interests of the City. He shall perform all such other duties as may be required of him by the City Council, and shall serve all notices within the City limits which the Council may direct him to serve.

Section 3. All sums due the City Marshal for the collection of City Taxes and for any (and all other services rendered the City shall be audited and paid in the same manner as other claims against the City, except that his fees in civil

and Criminal Cases, when Collected
may be retained by him.

Section 4. The City Marshal shall have
power to appoint, by written appointment
filed with the Recorder, and employ a
deputy, who shall hold his office as
deputy marshal subject to the orders and
requirements of the City Marshal in accor-
dance with and subject to the provisions
of City Ordinances in force, and such deputy
shall take an oath to faithfully
demean himself in office.

Section 5. All other ordinances or parts of
Ordinances relating to the qualification
and duties of the City Marshal are hereby
repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take
effect and be in full force from and
after its approval by the Mayor.

Ordinance No 161.

An Ordinance defining and Prescribing
the duties and Qualifications, and
fixing the Compensation of the City
Treasurer.

The People of the City of Albany
do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. Before entering upon the duties
of his office, the City Treasurer shall file
with the City Recorder a certificate of
his election with his oath of office
as prescribed by the City Charter endorsed
thereon, and also a bond payable to the
City of Albany in such sum as the City
Council may require, payable in Gold
Coin of the United States of America,
with two or more sureties, who shall
justify in double the penalty in the bond
and to be approved by the Mayor, con-
ditioned that he will faithfully and
discharge the duties of his office as
City Treasurer, account for and pay
over all money, and turn over to his
