

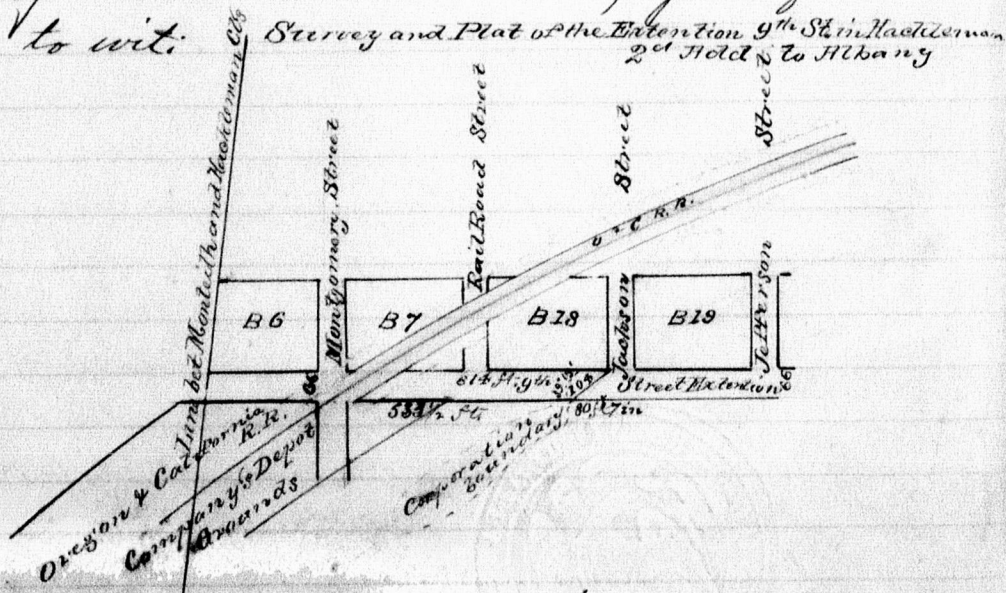
Ordinance no. 169

An Ordinance adopting the report of J. A. Warner, the surveyor appointed to survey a proposed extension of 9th Street from the eastern boundary line of Montgomery Street in the City of Albany along the south line of blocks 7 and 18 in Hackleman's second addition to the City of Albany to the eastern boundary line of said city.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows.

Section 1. That the report of J. A. Warner, the surveyor heretofore duly appointed by the Common Council of the City of Albany to survey a proposed extension of 9th Street from the Eastern boundary line of Montgomery Street in said City along the South line of blocks 7 and 18 in Hackleman's second addition to the City of Albany to the eastern boundary of said City, together with a plat of the survey of such proposed extension, which said said report and plat of survey are in the words and figures following to wit:

Notes and Plat of the Survey of the extension of 9th Street, from the east boundary of Montgomery St. extending along the south side of blocks 7 and 18 in Hackleman's Second Addition to Albany Oregon. Running from thence in an easterly direction 614 feet to the S. E. corner of block 18 in the abovesaid named Addition to the Corporation boundary line. Thence following said Corporation line in a southwesterly direction making an angle of $39^{\circ} 19'$ to the left of the south boundary of block 18 and 7; distance 104 feet to the south boundary of 9th Street extended. Thence westerly along south side of 9th Street 533 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the east boundary of Montgomery Street the place of Beginning. be and the same is hereby adopted by the Common Council of said City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the mayor.

An Ordinance to amend Section One of
an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance

The People of the City of Albany do ordain
as follows:

Section one. That Section 1 of an
Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to
amend Section One of an Ordinance
entitled An Ordinance to provide
for the prevention of fires and the protec-
tion of persons and property endangered
thereby," be amended so as to read as
follows:

Section 1. That the south half of Blocks
three (3) four (4) five (5) and six (6) (except
22 feet off of the west side of lot 6 and 22
feet off of the east side of lot 7 in the south
half of said block 6) provided a building be
erected thereon within 60 days from the
approval of this Ordinance, and the north
