An Ordinance to amend Section One of
An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance
to amend Section One of An Ordinance
entitled An Ordinance to provide for the
prevention of fires and the protection of persons,
and property endangered thereby."

The People of the City of Albany do ordain
as follows:

Section one. That Section 1 of an
Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to
amend Section one of an Ordinance
entitled An Ordinance to provide
for the prevention of fires and the protec-
tion of persons and property endangered
thereby," be amended so as to read as
follows:

Section 1. That the south half of Blocks
three (3) four (4) five (5) and six (6) (except
22 feet off of the west side of lot 6 and 22
feet off of the east side of lot 7 in the south
half of said block 6) provided a building be
erected thereon within 60 days from the
approval of this Ordinance, and the north

half of block seven (7) and the whole of
 Blocks eight (8) nine (9) and ten (10) in the
 city of Albany, (and the the south half
 of Block One (1) and the north half of
 Block Two (2) in the Eastern Addition to
 the City of Albany according to the
 maps, plats, and surveys of said City of
 Albany and the Eastern Addition to said
 City of Albany now on file and of record
 in the Office of the County Clerk of Linn
 County Oregon, be and the same are hereby
 declared to be within the fire limits
 of the City of Albany.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect,
 and be in full force from and after its
 Approval by the Mayor.

An Ordinance to prevent the rebate or
refunding of money paid for license.

The people of the City of Albany do
ordain as follows:

Section 1. That hereafter there shall
be no rebate allowed upon any license
issued, or to be issued by the City of
Albany for any purpose, and no
money paid or to be hereinafter paid
for any such license, nor any part
thereof, shall hereafter be refunded
because said license is surrendered or
for any reason what ever.

Section 2. This ordinance shall
take effect and be in full force,
from and after its approval by the
Mayor.
