

Ordinance No. 174

An ordinance authorizing the purchase of a Steam Fire Engine and providing the mode and manner of paying therefor.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City, be, and they are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed, in the name, and for the use of the City of Albany, to purchase from the Clapp & Jones Manufacturing Company of Hudson N.Y., a Clapp & Jones Steam fire engine No 4, at a price not to exceed the sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$3200⁰⁰), for the same, delivered on board the cars at Hudson N.Y. ready for shipment, to be paid for as follows: \$1,000⁰⁰ to be paid when said engine is delivered to, and accepted by the City authorities, after having been first fully tried and tested by the Fire Department of the City; \$1,000⁰⁰ to be paid May 1st 1889 with interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from the acceptance of said Engine by the City, until paid; and \$1200⁰⁰ or so much thereof as may be required, to be paid May 1st 1890 with interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from the date of the acceptance of such Engine by the City until paid. And said Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to enter into and execute

for, and in the name of the City of Albany, any contract in writing with the Clapp & Jones Manufacturing Company that may be necessary and proper to carry into effect the foregoing provisions of this section. The freight on such Engine from Hudson N.Y. to Albany, Oregon, shall be paid by the City when said Engine is delivered.

Section 2. That there be, and is hereby appropriated out of the City Treasury for the purpose of paying for said Engine, in the manner and at the times heretofore provided, the sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$3200⁰⁰), or so much thereof as may be required; and the further sum of Dollars (\$) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of paying the freight on said Engine from Hudson N.Y. to Albany, Oregon.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
