

Ordinance No. 187.

An Ordinance for the Protection of  
Fire Hoses, and to prevent obstructing  
the Streets during a fire.

The People of the City of Albany do  
Ordain as follows:

Section I. That any person or persons owning,  
driving, riding, or having charge of any  
wagon, truck, dray, horse car, or other  
vehicle, who shall drive, ride, lead, or  
haul, or, cause the same to be driven,  
rode, lead, or hauled over any line of  
fire hose belonging to the Fire Department,  
while the same is being used during a  
fire or for drill purposes, or any other  
service, (except by express order or consent of  
the Chief Engineer or Assistant Engineer,  
when absolutely necessary to move an  
Engine or hose-cart during the time of a  
fire), shall be deemed guilty of a mis-  
demeanor, and upon conviction thereof  
before the Recorder's Court, shall be fined  
not less than five dollars, nor more  
than twenty-five dollars, or by imprisonment  
in the City Jail not less than two days,  
nor more than twelve days.

Section II. The owner or driver of any wagon, truck,  
cart, dray, or other vehicle, who shall  
drive or leave such vehicle on any street,  
in such a manner, as to interfere with,  
or obstruct the passage of the fire  
apparatus, when a fire alarm has been  
given, or when working at a fire, and  
shall refuse or neglect to remove the

same, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be fined not less than five dollars, nor more than twenty-five dollars, or imprisoned in the City jail not less than two days, nor more than twelve days.

Section 10 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
