

Ordinance No. 189.

An Ordinance to regulate and fix  
the compensation of the Marshal.

The People of the city of Albany  
do Ordain as follows:

Section I. The Marshal shall receive in full  
Compensation for his services the  
sum of Fifty dollars per month, and  
also in addition thereto the sum  
of five (5) per cent on all city taxes  
collected by him.

Section II. The Marshall shall not hold  
any other office, and shall devote  
his entire time to the duties  
incumbent upon him as Marshal

Section III. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances  
in conflict herewith are hereby  
repealed.

Section IV. This Ordinance to be in force and  
take effect from and after the  
first ~~Monday~~ in January 1890.
