Ordinance No. 304.

An Ordinance to amend Section (6) Six of Ordinance Number 161, entitled "An Ordinance defining and prescribing the duties and qualifications, and fixing the Compensation of the City Treasurer", passed by the Council August 16<sup>th</sup> 1887, and approved by the Mayor August 23<sup>rd</sup> 1887.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That Section (6) Six of Ordinance Number 161 entitled, "An Ordinance defining and prescribing the duties and qualifications, and fixing the Compensation of the City Treasurer passed by the Council August 16<sup>th</sup> 1887, and approved by the Mayor August 23<sup>rd</sup> 1887, be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 6: The City Treasurer shall receive as his salary the sum of ~~Two~~ Two Hundred dollars per annum which shall be paid quarterly out of the treasury, the same as other claims against the City are paid.

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance to be in full force, and take effect from and after the first Monday in January 1891.

Passed by the Council November 11<sup>th</sup> 1890.

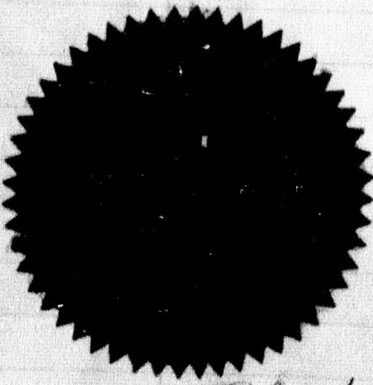
