An Ordinance to amend Section 19 of Ordinance No 133, entitled "An Ordinance to provide for the prevention of fires and the protection of persons and property endangered thereby and to provide a penalty for the violation of said Section 19, as by the following ordinance amended.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 19. of Ordinance No 133. entitled. "An ordinance to provide for the prevention of fires and the protection of persons and property endangered thereby" be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
Section 19. That no person or persons Company or Corporation, nor any person as the Agent, Employee or representative of any other person or persons Company or Corporation shall keep for sale, on storage or otherwise within the fire limits of the City of Albany, more than two hundred gallons of Coal Oil, nor more than ten gallons of Gasoline, nor more than ten gallons of Naphtha, all of the same to be securely kept in metallic cans or tanks. And no person or persons, Company or Corporation nor any person as the Agent, Employee or representative of any other person Company or Corporation, shall keep for sale or on storage within the Corporate limits of said City, outside of the fire limits thereof, any Coal Oil, Gasoline or Naphtha, unless the same be kept in metallic cans or tanks inside of a fire proof building

Section 2. And any person either as his own representative or as the Agent, Employee or representative of any other person or persons Company or Corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of said Section 19. as hereby amended shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$50⁰⁰ nor more than \$100⁰⁰ or be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than 25 days nor more than 50 days

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor
