

Ordinance No 218.

An Ordinance authorizing, and directing the Mayor and Recorder to enter into written articles of Agreement with the Portland Bridge, and Building Company of Portland Oregon their associates and assigns for the building and completion for the city of a high steel free Wagon bridge across the Willamette River at the northern terminus of Calapooia Street in the City of Albany.

The People of the City of Albany
do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and Recorder are hereby directed, and authorized and empowered to enter into and sign, on behalf of the City written articles of agreement, with the Portland Bridge and Building Company of Portland Oregon its associates and assigns, for the building and completion by said Company its associates and assigns, for the City, of a high, steel, free, wagon bridge across the Willamette River at the northern terminus of Calapooia Street in said City of Albany, at a cost of not exceeding \$83,350⁰⁰, such bridge to be completed within 4 months from the signing of such articles of agreement, by said Company and said Mayor and Recorder.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force, and effect, from and after its approval by the Mayor
