

Ordinance No. 233

An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor of the City of Albany to execute and sign a stipulation and agreement with the Secretary of War of the Government of the United States of America, relating to the construction of a bridge across the Willamette River at the City of Albany by said City.

Ord 233

Whereas the Congress of the United States by an act approved December 26<sup>th</sup> 1890, entitled "An act authorizing the City of Albany in the County of Linn State of Oregon to construct a bridge across the Willamette River in said State at the City of Albany in the County of Linn, State of Oregon authorizing said City of Albany to construct a bridge over the Willamette River at a point opposite said City and between the Counties of Linn and Benton Oregon upon obtaining the approval of the Secretary of War of such designs and drawings and maps of the location of a proposed bridge over said river at said place which comply with the requirements of the said act;"

And Whereas The City of Albany in the State of Oregon has submitted to the Secretary of War, for his examination and approval a design and drawings, and a map of the location of the said bridge so proposed to be built at said point which comply with the requirements of said act and which have been approved by the Secretary of War subject to the following conditions; That the Engineer Officer of the United States Army in Charge of the district within which said bridge is to be built, may supervise its construction in order that said plans shall be complied with;

And Whereas the Secretary of War of the United States has submitted to the said City of Albany for its acceptance a stipulation and agreement in writing containing the foregoing conditions;

Therefore  
The People of the City of Albany do  
Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor of said city, be and he is hereby  
authorized and directed to sign said stipulation  
and agreement on behalf of and for said city,  
thereby accepting by said city of Albany said conditions  
and said Act of Congress.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and  
effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
