

Ordinance No 249

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany Oregon to enter into a contract in writing with the Portland Bridge and Building Company of Portland Oregon for the construction of the approaches to the Calapooia Street Bridge at the terminus of said Bridge in Benton County

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows.

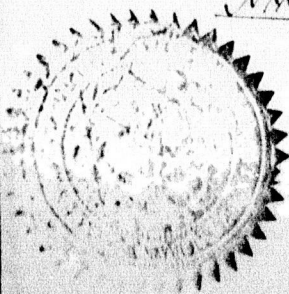
Section 1 That the Mayor and Recorder of the said City of Albany be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into and sign a contract in writing with the Portland Bridge and Building Company of Portland Oregon for the construction of the Benton County approaches to the High Street wagon Bridge across the Willamette River and known as Calapooia Street Bridge said approaches to begin at the north terminus of the approaches to be constructed by said Bridge Company as provided in the contract entered into July 29th 1891

Section 2 This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
