Repealing Ord. 2105

Ordinance No: 268.

An Ordinance providing for, and defining, the kind, and quality of Sewer pipe to be used in the construction of Lateral Sewers in the City of Albany Oregon.

The People of ^{the} City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That all lateral sewers which may hereafter be constructed in the streets, and through all the alleys, and the center of all blocks, in the City of Albany, Oregon, whether such sewers are constructed by the City, or by the property owners of said City, shall be constructed of the best quality of vitrified, Iron Stone Sewer pipe, to be not less than (8) eight inches inside diameter.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
