

Ordinance No. 272

An Ordinance authorizing and empowering the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into and sign written articles of agreement with the "Albany Electric Light, Power, and Telephone Company" of Albany Oregon, their associates and assigns for furnishing the city of Albany, Oregon, with Arc, and Incandescent Electric Lights for a term of three years from the 1st day of October, 1893.

Ord. No. 272

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon is hereby authorized, directed, and empowered to enter into, and sign on behalf of the City of Albany, written articles of agreement with the "Albany Electric Light, Power, and Telephone Company" of Albany Oregon, their associates and assigns, for furnishing the City of Albany for a term of three years from Oct 1st 1893, with ten (10) Arc Street lights of (200) two thousand candle power, and all night service, at the price of (\$10) ten dollars per month for each of such lights furnished the city, the same price per light to be paid for each Arc light of the same power and time of service, all above the number 10, which may from time to time be ordered by the Common Council of the City of Albany, and shall be used by said city, and be a part of the contract, ^{and remain in force} during the time and continuance of the contract authorized by this Ordinance.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
