

Ordinance No 274.

An Ordinance to amend section (6) of Ordinance number 204, entitled, "An Ordinance to amend section (6) of Ordinance number 161, entitled, "An Ordinance defining, and prescribing the duties, and qualifications, and fixing the compensation of the City Treasurer," passed by the Council August 16th 1887, and approved by the Mayor August 23rd 1887.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows

Section 1: That section 6 of Ordinance number 204, entitled, "An Ordinance to amend section (6) of Ordinance number 161, entitled, "An Ordinance defining and prescribing the duties, and qualifications, and fixing the compensation of the City Treasurer," passed by the Council August 16th 1887, and approved by the Mayor August 23rd 1887, be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 6: The City Treasurer shall receive as his salary the sum of (\$100.00) One Hundred dollars per annum, which shall be paid quarterly out of the treasury the same as other claims against the city are paid.

Section 2: All ordinances, or parts of Ordinance in so far as they are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect, and be in force from and after the first day of February 1894.
