An Ordinance to amend section (3) here, and section (5) here of ordinance no. 4, entitled, "An ordinance to License, Tax, and Regulate certain Callings, Trades, and Employments, and to provide for the manner of issuing Licenses", passed by the Council, February 7th, 1886, and approved by the Mayor February, 10th, 1886.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That section (3) here of ordinance number 4, entitled, "An ordinance to tax, license, tax, and regulate certain callings, trades, and employments, and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses", passed by the Council February 7th, 1886, and approved by the Mayor February, 10th, 1886, be, and the same is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

Section 2: Any non-resident peddler, agent, canvasser, solicitor, or other non-resident person, who shall conduct his, or her business, within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, shall pay a license therefor, as follows: when traveling with two, or more animals \$7.00 per day, \$20.00 per month, or \$60.00 per quarter; when traveling with one animal \$6.00 per day, \$18.00 per month, or \$54.00 per quarter; when traveling on foot \$5.00 per day, \$15.00 per month, or \$45.00 per quarter. Any person, except persons peddling newspapers, bibles, or religious tracts, and farmers, or persons peddling the products of their own farms, gardens, or milk ranches, or dairies, and whole sale agents, (selling to regular dealers only) who sell, or offer to sell, at retail, or who sell, or offer to sell by subscription, or by sample, or by soliciting orders for any books, or books, merchandise, notions, pictures, and works of art, wares, or commodities of any kind, traveling from place, to place within the limits of the City of Albany shall be deemed a peddler.

Section 2. That section 5 of said ordinance number 141 be, and the same, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 5. The Keeper, or proprietor of every circus, or menagerie shall pay a license of \$50.00 per day every building, tent, space, or area, where feats of horsemanship, or acrobatic feats, or sports are exhibited, shall be deemed a circus under this ordinance; and every building, tent, space, or area where wild, or caged animals are exhibited shall be deemed a menagerie under this ordinance; provided that a circus and menagerie combined, exhibiting under one, and the same building, tent, space, or area, shall pay but one license of \$50.00 per day.

Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in so far as they conflict with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect, and be in force from, and after its approval by the mayor.
