

Ordinance No. 301.

All Ordinances, relating to interest on City warrants, issued after October 8th 1898, and on contracts and obligations of the City of Albany, made, and entered into after said date.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That, no City warrant, or warrants issued after the passage of this Ordinance, and no contract, or obligation, of any kind hereafter entered into by the City of Albany, shall bear interest; and no interest shall be paid on any City warrant, or warrants, issued after said date, or on any contract, or obligation of said City, hereafter made, or entered into.

Section 2: All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force, and effect after its approval by the Mayor.
