

ORDINANCE NO. 316.

Ordinance  
No. 316

All Ordinances, authorizing, and enforcing the Mayor, and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into, and sign, written articles of agreement, with David Roman, of Albany, Oregon, for leasing and renting to the City of Albany, for the term of five (5) years, from the first day of February 1897, two rooms in the Roman Block, for the use of said city, as Council Chamber, and City offices.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That, the Mayor, and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, be, and they are hereby authorized, directed, and enjoined to enter into, and sign on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, written articles of agreement, with David Roman of Albany, Oregon, leasing, and renting from the said David Roman, for the use of said City, as Council Chamber, and City Offices, for the term of five (5) years from the first day of February 1897, the following described premises to wit:

The west (two) rooms in the second story, and fronting on First street, of the brick building known as Roman's Block, located on lots 6 and 7, in block No. 3, in Albany, Oregon, and immediately east of, and adjoining the "Masonic Temple".

The said City of Albany, to pay to the said David Roman for the use, and occupancy of said rooms the sum of five (5.00) dollars per month to be paid quarterly, out of the City Treasury, as other claims against the City are audited, and paid.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
