Ordinance

An Ordinance to provide for the keeping of
Animals taken up, and impounded in the city
limits.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain
as follows:

Section 1: That the keeping of animals prohibited from
running at large within the corporate limits of the
City of Albany, Oregon, which are taken up, and
impounded by the City Commissioner, shall be
by contract, and shall be let by the Council to the
lowest responsible bidder; Bids for keeping such
animals shall be advertised for in the same manner,
and at the same time each year, as other annual bids
are advertised for, and received.

Section 2: That, all Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict
with this Ordinance, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force
from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
