Ord. 716 525 Amend. 706 Rep 809, 1507 An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No 317, entitled, "An Ordinance to License Tax and regulate Billiard Rooms, and Pool Rooms, and to repeal so much of Section 14, of Ordinance No 141, Entitled, "An Ordinance to License Tax, and regulate certain Callings, and employments, to provide for the manner of issuing licenses." Approved July 10<sup>th</sup> 1896," as relates to Billiard, and Pool Rooms. Approved March 26<sup>th</sup> 1897.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: If any person duly licensed to engage in keeping a Billiard, or Pool Room in the City of Albany, shall allow or permit any minor under the age of Eighteen years, to visit, loiter around, or frequent his place of business, or play at any game of Billiard, or Pool, in said place of business, without the written consent of the parent, or guardian of such minor, shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, be punished by a fine of not less than five, nor more than ten dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not less than five, nor more, than ten days, or by both such fine, and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 2: That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the mayor.
