

ORDINANCE NO. 325.

Ord. No. 325 An Ordinance authorizing, and empowering the Committee on Streets, and Public Property of the City of Albany, Oregon, to receive bids for, and purchase all the pipe, and other necessary material required, for the construction of a Water Pipe line, for fire purposes, in Third street, from the "Albany and Santiam" ditch to Ellsworth street in said city.

The People of the City of Albany, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That, the Committee on Streets, and Public Property of the City of Albany, Oregon, be, and said Committee is hereby authorized, directed, and empowered, to receive bids for, and purchase, at the lowest price obtainable, all the 10-12, and 24 inch pipe, to be of the best quality of "Kiln Fired Lava Stone Pipe," and all other material which may be necessary, and required for the construction, and laying of a "Water Pipe Line" for fire purposes in Third street, from the "Albany and Santiam" ditch, to Ellsworth street, in said city; And the Mayor, and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized, and empowered by this Ordinance, to enter into, and sign, written articles of agreement, with the person, or persons, firm, or corporation, from whom whence the said committee purchase said pipe, and material, in accordance with the terms, and at the price agree upon, and accepted by the Committee on Streets, and Public Property of said City.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force, from and after its approval by the Mayor.
