

ORDINANCE NO. 329.

Ord 76 329 An Ordinance Authorizing and Empowering the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into, and sign written Articles of Agreement with the "Albany Iron Works" of said City for making certain repairs, and improvements to the "Fire Engine" of said Engine Co. No. Two.

The People of the City of Albany, do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That, the Mayor, and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, be, and they are hereby authorized, directed, and Empowered, to enter into, and sign written Articles of Agreement with the "Albany Iron Works" of said City for making all the improvements, and repairs to the Fire Engine of "Fire Engine Company" No. Two, which may be necessary and required, to put such Engine in a first class serviceable condition; the contract price for making such improvements, and repairs not to exceed the sum of \$25.00.

Section 2: That, this Ordinance take effect, and be in full force, from, and after its approval by the Mayor
