

Ord. No. 341 A
An ordinance of the City of Albany, New York, in the County of Albany, State of New York, passed at a meeting of the Common Council, held at the Hall of the City of Albany, on the 19th day of October, 1900, for the construction of a "Water Pipe" for fire purposes on the East side of Second street, between First and Second streets, in said city, and the same is to be located with two supply wells in connection with it.

The People of the City of Albany, do claim as follows:

Section I. Plot the Mason's Measure at the 1st, or Albany Common, by and the day, as follows: to be signed, sealed and acknowledged, to be witnessed and signed written authority of an engineer with H. C. Fire Board of said city, for the construction of a main or a water pipe line 6" of iron, 12" thick vitrified iron stone pipe including all material and labor necessarily required, on the East side of Ferry street from a connection with the already constructed water pipe line, at the South side of Second street, to the South side of First street in said city, and the construction of two supply wells, not less than 6 feet deep by 2 feet in diameter, to be constructed of vitrified ironstone containing sand and loam 10" thick, one well to be located in the water pipe line on the North side of First street and one well at the end of said water pipe line at South side of First street at the rate and price of 105%, it is first on the basis for acts as set forth and substituted in the said aforesaid H. C. Fire Board and the Common Council of Albany and Public Report Oct. 19, 1900 and accepted by the City of Albany Oct. 22, 1900.

Section II. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force now and after its approval by the Mayor.
