

Ord. No. 341

That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany  
 be and they are authorized and directed  
 to empower, to enter into and sign written  
 articles of agreement with H. C. Ha Krest of  
 said City, for the reconstruction of a water pipe  
 in water pipe line of eight inches vitrified  
 iron stone pipe including all material and  
 labor necessary to make, on the East side of Ferry  
 street from a connection with the already const-  
 ructed water pipe lines at the South side of  
 Second street, to the South side of First street  
 in said City, and the construction of two supply  
 wells, not less than 6 feet deep by 2 feet in  
 diameter, to be constructed of vitrified iron stone  
 combined furnished by the City, one well to be located  
 in the water pipe line on the North side of Ferry  
 street and one well at the end of said water pipe line  
 at South side of First street at the rate and price  
 of \$6500, it is provided on said water pipe line as set  
 forth in a stipulated contract and a Joint J. C. Markham  
 under title to the Common title on Streets and  
 Public Property Oct. 19, 1900 and accepted by the  
 City Council Oct. 22, 1900

The People of the City of Albany do enact  
 as follows:

Section I. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany  
 be and they are authorized and directed  
 to empower, to enter into and sign written  
 articles of agreement with H. C. Ha Krest of
