

## ORDINANCE NO. 342.

Ord. No. 342. Be it Ordinance authorizing and empowering the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany, to enter into, enter into, or will, a lease or agreement with the Oregon Light & Telephone Company, or other company, for furnishing the light & power, and telephone, and telegraph service to the City of Albany, and the residents and business men of the City of Albany, in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the contract.

Section I. That the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany,

and are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed, to enter into and sign, on behalf of said City, written articles of agreement with the "Oregon Light & Telephone Company" of Albany, Oregon, their successors or assigns, for furnishing the City of Albany, for one year from the day of - 1900 to the 26-day of January, 1901 with 10,2000 foot candle power Electric arc Street lights, and a 1200 incandescent night service at the price of \$5.00 per month during at the rate of  $\frac{1}{2}$  cent per each light per month, the price to be paid for each additional light which may be ordered by the City Council of said City, as furnished by said Company above, the number of 10 lights to be supplied, and for each of such additional lights to be ordered, and shall be included in monthly payment as part of the contract during the term of contract, and so the contract, or terminated by this Ordinance.

Section II. This Ordinance shall take effect in full force and as aforesaid, upon its approval by the Mayor,
