ORDINANCE NO. 358

passed December 10, 1901

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Passed
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An Ordinance authorizing the laying and construction of a drain and curbing in the South side of Ninth Street in the City of Albany, Oregon adjacent to parallel with and 12 feet from the North line of the following described property to-wit:— Beginning at a point 66 feet South $90^{\circ}24'$ East from the South West corner of Block No. 68 in said City, running thence North $80^{\circ}36'$ East 602 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet on the South line of Ninth Street in said City; thence South $90^{\circ}24'$ East 506 feet; thence South $80^{\circ}36'$ West 602 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence North $90^{\circ}24'$ West 506 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.99 acres more or less and to authorize the Mayor and Recorder of said City to enter into a contract on the part of the City of Albany, for the construction of the same and providing for the cost and expense of laying and constructing said drain and curbing to be assessed to the owners and holders of lots and parts of lots abutting and adjoining said drain and curbing.

The People of the City of Albany, Oregon do Ordain as follows:—

Section 1.— That there be constructed in the South side of Ninth street in the City of Albany, Oregon adjacent to parallel with and 12 feet from the North line of the following described property to-wit:— Beginning at a point 66 feet South $90^{\circ}24'$ East from the Southwest corner of Block No. 68 in the City of Albany, Oregon, running thence North $80^{\circ}36'$ East 602 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet on the South line of Ninth street in said City; thence South $90^{\circ}24'$ East 506 feet thence South $80^{\circ}36'$ West 602 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet thence North $90^{\circ}24'$ West 506 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.99 acres more or less a drain and curbing, said curbing to be of wood not less than three inches in thickness and not less than 12 inches in depth, and that the Mayor and Recorder of said City of Albany are hereby authorized directed and empowered to enter into and sign on the part of the City of Albany, Oregon, written articles of agreement for the laying and construction of the above described drain and curbing adjacent to the above described property, that the cost of laying and construction of said

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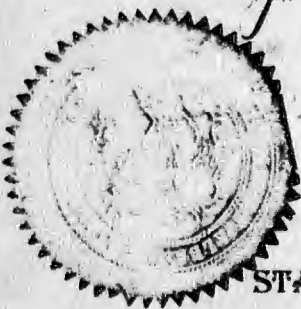
Drain and curbing be assessed to the owners and holders of lots and parts of lots abutting on and adjacent to such drain and curbing when constructed. Provided that said contract shall not be entered into and said articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder on the part of the City until after proposals for the construction of such curbing and drain has been advertised for in the manner provided for by the City Charter and Ordinances, regulating the awarding of contracts, and bids have been received and considered by the Council and the contract awarded by the Council and the cost and expense of laying and constructing said drain and curbing are fixed and determined.

Section 2:- This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
