A bill for an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and City Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract with S. E. Young and P. A. Goodwin for the leasing of rooms for the occupancy of the Officers of the City of Albany."

The City of Albany does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with S. E. Young and P. A. Goodwin for the leasing of two rooms located in the southeast corner of the two-story brick building owned by them and situated at the corner of second and Broadway Streets, in the City of Albany, Oregon, for the period of five years at a monthly rental of \$19.00 per month, the same to be paid for quarterly in warrants drawn upon said City.

Section 2. - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
