

ORDINANCE No. 3-2

A bill for an ordinance declaring an acce-
ment and fixing and establishing a lien
for street improvements on N. E. 1/4 of Block
No. 34 of Jackson's Second Addition to
the City of Albany, Oregon, within the City
of Albany, the same being the interests of
and owned by Geo. Kuper, for the repairing
of a sidewalk adjacent along the south
side of Fifth Street abutting said lots.

The Purse of the City of Albany do
ordain as follows: -

Section I. - That whereas on the 11th day
of November 1902 a resolution was duly
passed by the City Council of the City of
Albany declaring the intention to
improve Fifth Street on the South
side thereof and adjacent to the North
East 1/4 of Block 34 of Jackson's Second
Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon,
the same being the property of Geo. Kuper
and caused the said Geo. Kuper to give
notice thereof to be given as provided by law,
and no objections or remonstrations
being made to the proposed improve-
ments or to the repairing of said side-
walk; and thereafter on the 20th day
of November 1902 the said City Council
of Albany duly passed an ordinance
declaring the time and manner of
repairing said sidewalk and authorizing
the Mayor and Recorder to enter into
a contract to repair said sidewalk,
which said ordinance was published
and became a law, and thereafter a
contract was duly made and the
repair thereof and the Superintendent
of streets having charge of such
work as City Engineer having re-
ported that the work cost of advertising
and repairing of said sidewalk and other
costs connected therewith amounted to
the sum of \$35.20.

That there be and hereby is assessed upon said
 West-East 1/4 of Block 34 of Seaside main
 Second Addition to the City of Albany Oregon
 the property of said Eric Lief the sum of
 \$35.25 and the amount shall be a lien
 upon said lots and the whole thereof
 until the full payment thereof.

That the recorder be and he is hereby directed
 to give notice to the said Eric Lief the owner
 of said lots of the assessment of said costs upon said
 property and the interest thereon as made by the
 said sum is not paid within ten days after
 the giving of said notice, that the Recorder
 of the City of Albany issue a warrant under
 the seal of the City for the collection of the same
 directed to the City Marshal commanding him
 to forthwith levy upon and sell said property as
 provided by law.

Section II - This ordinance shall have full force and
 effect from and after its approval by Mayor
