

ORDINANCE NO. 279

Passed by the council March 24 1903.

Ord No 373 A bill for an ordinance authorizing and empowering
Passed by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Albany to enter into
a contract with L Foley and the purchase of lumber for
Mar 24 1903 City of Albany Seal.

The People of the City of Albany do hereby ordain as
follows:-

Section I:- That there be and there is
hereby given and granted unto the Mayor and
Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, full
power and authority to enter into a
contract on behalf of said City of Albany
with L Foley for the purchase of lumber
for the use and benefit of said City of
Albany; to the amount of six thousand
feet, at the rate of \$9.00 per thousand, the
same to be classed F. C. B. the same at
sawed, merchantable, rough lumber in
sizes and dimensions to be hereafter
furnished by the City on its author-
ized officers and the said Mayor and
Recorder are hereby empowered and
authorized to sign a contract on behalf
of the said City of Albany for the purchase
of the same.

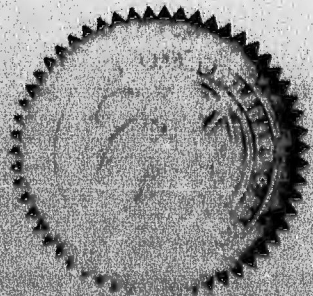
Section II:- This ordinance shall
