An Ordinance authorizing and directing the building and laying of a cement or artificial stone sidewalk and curbing in front of and adjacent to the Real Property hereinafter described: Lots 1 and 8 in Block 7, in the City of Albany, Oregon, on the West side thereof; also the East two-thirds of lot 2, and the West one-half of lot 3, in Block 2, in the Eastern addition to said city, on the North side thereof; and to authorize the Mayor and Recorder of said city of Albany to enter into a contract on the part of and on behalf of the City of Albany, for the construction of the same; and providing for the costs and expenses of the building and laying of said sidewalks and curbs to be assessed to the owners and holders of lots or parts of lots abutting on and adjoining said sidewalks and curbs; and matters kindred thereto:

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section I: That there be constructed and laid a sidewalk and curb on the east side of Ellsworth Street, abutting on the west line of lot 8 in block 7 in said city, property of C. Sullivan and J. Weatherford. Also on the east side of Ellsworth Street abutting on the west line of lot 1, in said block 7, the property of J. Weatherford.

Also on the south side of First Street abutting on the north line of the east two-thirds of lots in Block 2 in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, the property of J. P. Wallace.

Also on the south side of First Street abutting on the north line of the west half of lot 3, in said Block 2, the property of A. Broschel.

That the cost of construction, laying and building of said sidewalk and curbing be assessed to the owners of lots and parts of lots abutting on and adjacent to said sidewalk, when constructed; that said sidewalk and curbing be constructed of cement or

artificial stone, of the width and consistancy and according to the survey and regulations of the ordinances of said city; and that the Mayor and Recorder of said city of Albany, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into and sign on the part of the city of Albany written articles of agreement for the construction and laying of said cement or artificial stone sidewalks and curbs as above set forth; Provided, That said contract shall not be entered into or such articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder on the part of said city until after proposals for the construction of said sidewalks and curbs have been advertised for in the manner provided by the city charter, and ordinances of the said city of Albany regulating the awarding of contracts and bids have been received and considered by the council, the contract awarded by the council, and the costs and expenses of such construction shall have been fixed and determined.

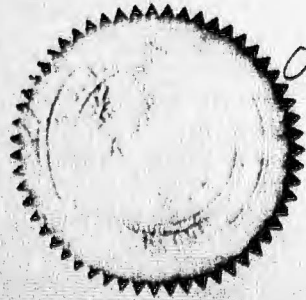
Section II:- This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
