

ORDINANCE NO. 398

Passed March 14th 1905

This Ordinance #398 was passed by the Council notwithstanding the disapproval of the Mayor March 28th 1905

An ordinance to fix the compensation of the City Recorder; to provide for the payment to the City Treasurer of certain fees collected by the City Recorder; and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-

Sec. 1: - That from and after the 1st day of April 1905 the recorder shall receive as full compensation for his services both as recorder and as clerk of the Council an annual salary of \$900.00 payable monthly out of the general fund by warrant drawn upon the Treasurer.

Sec. 2: - It shall be the duty of the recorder, from and after the said 1st day of April 1905, to exact and collect for the use of the City of Albany all fees and charges which the recorder is now authorized or required by law or the ordinances of the City of Albany to collect or receive from third persons on any account whatsoever, and the recorder shall keep a fee book in which shall be entered all such fees and charges collected by him, with the names of the persons by whom the same were paid and on what account the same were paid, the said fee book to be a public record; and the Recorder shall on or before the first day of each month, deposit all such sums collected during the previous month with the City Treasurer, who shall give him duplicate receipts therefor, one of which shall be filed in the recorder's office.

Sec. 3: - All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
