

ORDINANCE No. 402

Passed March 14<sup>th</sup> 1905

Ord 402 An Ordinance to establish the width of wooden side-walks on First Street between Railroad Street and Main Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

Passed 3-14-05

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:—

Section 1. That all wooden sidewalks hereafter <sup>built and</sup> constructed on First Street between Railroad Street and Main Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be six feet in width, and shall be <sup>hereafter</sup> built and constructed in accordance with the established ordinances of said City relating to the building and construction of <sup>such</sup> sidewalks.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
