Ord 432 An Ordinance regulating the driving and moving

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Passed Section. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons
8-27-1907 to drive or move any cow or cows, horse or horses, cattle or
Pep 1221 other animals through any public street or alley within
103 the City of Albany, Oregon without having control of said
animal or animals with reins or ropes or other fasten-
ing, and in the hands of some person sufficiently
able to manage and control said animal or animals
within the following described district in said City
to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the south bank of the
main channel of the Willamette River, at the Northwest
of Thurston Street, thence Southward along Thurston Street
to Ninth Street, thence Westward along Ninth Street to
a point sixty six feet South of the South East Corner
of block No. 105 in Megallen's Second Addition
to the City of Albany; thence Southwardly in a straight
line to the South East Corner of block Ninety-six in
Montith's Southern Addition to the City of Albany;
thence Westward and parallel with the South boundary
line of Elmwood Street to the Southwest corner of block
No. 105 in Montith's Southern Addition to the City of
Albany; thence Northward along the East line of Elm
Street to Fifth Street, thence Eastward on Fifth Street to
Maple Street; thence Northward on Maple Street to
Culver Creek; thence down said Creek following
the meanders thereof, to the South bank of the main
channel of the Willamette River; thence down said
South bank of said river to the place of beginning.
Provided however, that this Ordinance shall not
apply to persons driving or moving stock for
market or transportation through said district
above described, and in charge of a competent
holder.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any
person or persons to drive or move any stock
or animals through any public street or alley

within the City of Albany, for market transportation or other purposes without being in charge of a competent herder, or to permit or allow the same to trespass or go upon the premises of any person, unless the owner or owners of such stock or animals shall have first obtained permission of the owners or tenants of said premises.

Section. 3. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 or shall be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than two days nor more than twenty five days, or both at the discretion of the Court.

Section. 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after thirty days after its approval by the Mayor.
