An Ordinance relating to the construction of sidewalks and curbs to be made of artificial stone or cement on Lyon Street, from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Tenth Street; and changing the width of sidewalks on Vine Street, in the City of Albany, Logan County, Oregon, and repealing all ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith:

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. All sidewalks that may hereafter be constructed on Lyon Street, from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Tenth Street in the City of Albany, shall be made of artificial stone or cement, the same shall be eight feet wide and built along the property line.

Section 2. Along the front of the sidewalk described in section 1. of this Ordinance, shall be placed a curb of artificial stone or cement, twelve feet from, and parallel with the front line of the lot or block, to the outer edge of the curb along which the said sidewalk is constructed:

Section 3. That all sidewalks that may hereafter be constructed on Vine Street, in the City of Albany, shall be made of artificial stone or cement, and shall be five feet in width and built along the property line, the outer edge thereof forming the curb.

Section 4. That all sidewalks and curbs provided for in this Ordinance, shall be constructed by use of like material, and the several parts thereof to conform in all respects to the manner and form provided by ordinance, and in accordance with specifications and surveys for the construction of sidewalks and curbs now in force in the Cement district and on file in the Office of the Recorder of the City of Albany.

Section 5. That all ordinances and parts of

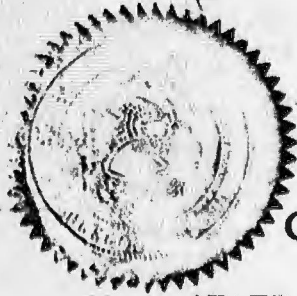
