

ORDINANCE NO. 457

Chas. K. Spaulding permission to erect shed

An Ordinance granting the Chas. K. Spaulding Logging Company permission to erect a lumber yard structure on Lots Three and Four in Block Three in the City of Albany, and remove a barn on said lots.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That the Chas. K. Spaulding Logging Co. be and it is by this Ordinance granted the right and permission to erect a shed to be known as a lumber yard structure on lots three and four in Block Three in the City of Albany in Linn County Oregon on the East side of the said lots, the same to be set on posts and to be twenty four feet wide, and to extend the full length of the said lot from on Ferry Street, the outer wall on the said street to be twenty feet high and constructed of corrugated iron, the South end of the said shed to contain an Office ten by twelve by twenty four feet, constructed of corrugated iron, and the whole of the said structure to be covered with two ply molthead roofing, all to be built in a good and substantial manner and so as to be the least liable to fire.

Section 2: That the said Chas. K. Spaulding Logging Co. be and it is hereby permitted to remove the barn that now stands on the southwest corner of the said lots mentioned in Section 1. of this act, to the Northwest corner thereof.

Section 3. Inas much as the erection of the said lumber yard and the removal of the said barn will greatly lessen the liability and danger of fire in the vicinity of the said lots, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
