An Ordinance Amending section one of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Regulating the Construction of Wooden Awnings and Signs over sidewalk on certain Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon" passed by the Council of said City February 8, 1901. And to declare an emergency.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordains Follows: Section 1. That Section one of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance regulating the construction of wooden awnings and signs over sidewalk on certain Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon" passed by the Council of said City February 8, 1901, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. No wooden awning, shade, balcony or porch shall be constructed or maintained by any person, or be suffered to be constructed or maintained by any person over any sidewalk in the City of Albany East of Washington Street and West of Montgomery Street between the north boundary line of First Street and the south boundary line of Third Street in said City of Albany, Oregon. Such awnings, when desired shall not be less than seven feet above the top of the sidewalk over which such cloth awnings are placed or maintained, and shall be supported upon iron arms so as to permit such awnings to be easily folded up against the building when such awning is in front of, and the lower portion of such arms or supports shall be at least eight feet above the top of the sidewalk over which such awnings are placed or maintained. And it is hereby made the duty of every person owning or maintaining any wooden awning, shade, balcony or porch

over any sidewalk set in front of any building or premises owned, controlled or occupied by such person within the district in this section described, to remove the same within twenty days from the date of the approval of this ordinance by the Mayor of said City.

And every person failing to comply with the provisions of this section or violating any of the provisions thereof, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of said City, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00 for each such offense, or by imprisonment in the City Jail of said City not less than two days nor more than 12 days for each such offense, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. And each day any such wooden awning, shade, or balcony or porch is maintained or allowed to remain over any such sidewalk by the owner or person having the possession or control thereof shall be deemed a separate and distinct misdemeanor under the provisions of this ordinance, and a separate violation thereof.
