

ORDINANCE NO. 496

Relating to signs, & advertisements on sidewalks

Repealed by 1506

An Ordinance amending Section two of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance regulating the Construction of Wooden Awnings and Signs over Sidewalks on certain Streets in the City of Albany Oregon" passed by the Council of said City February 8, 1909

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section two of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance regulating the Construction of Wooden Awnings and Signs over Sidewalks on certain Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon" passed by the Council of said City February 8, 1909, be and the same is hereby amended so far to read as follows:

Section 2. No person shall within the City of Albany Oregon place or maintain, or cause or suffer to be placed or maintained, upon or over any street or sidewalk of said City in front of or adjacent to any building, structure or premises, or otherwise, any sign, advertisement, flag or other contrivance, except on holidays, Election days and days of public parade, provided that electric signs may be used on sidewalks in front of buildings, as far out as to the curb line in front of such buildings and no farther, but all such electric signs shall be so constructed as to be easily swung back against the building. They are for front of when not in use, and all such electrical signs shall be kept swung back from over the sidewalk in the day time between the hours of 7 o'clock A. M. and 6 o'clock P. M. during the months of June, July, August and September, and between the hours of 7 o'clock A. M. and 5 o'clock P. M. during the months of October, November, December, January, February, March, April and May by the person or persons owning, operating or maintaining such electrical sign or signs.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of said City, shall be punished for each such offense by a fine of not less than five dollars

not more than twenty five dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than two nor more than ten days at the discretion of said Court, or by both such fine and imprisonment, if said Court thinks proper under the circumstances of the case.
