

## ORDINANCE No. 507

Relating to time and manner of paving part of Broadalbin Street - from Third to North Streets

An Ordinance, providing for the time and manner for improving Broadalbin Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the North curb line of Third Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street, providing that the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damages, that shall be paid to the City of Albany, by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work by such person or persons of said Street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City proper notice or bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said Street.

The People of <sup>the City of</sup> Albany do Ordain as follows:

- Section I - That Broadalbin Street from the North curb line of Third Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street shall be improved in the following manner to-wit:
- First: By grading said Street to the proper sub-grade.
  - Second: By paving the roadway of said Street full width, with full intersections with City and State Government.
  - Third: By laying and constructing Curb and gutter.
  - Fourth: By constructing Sinks.
  - Fifth: By constructing Catch Basins.
  - Sixth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the Plans, Specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City, for the improvement of Broadalbin Street, filed in the office of the City Recorder of said City of Albany on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of Dec, 1909, endorsed "City Engineer's Plans and Specifications for the improvement of Broad-

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albin Street from the North curb line of Third Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street, and the estimates of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof.

The cost of the said improvement of said portion of said Broadalbin Street, at the crossing or intersections thereof by third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth streets, and that portion of Ninth Street lying between the North curb line of Ninth Street and the North line thereof, shall be paid by the City of Albany out of the general fund of the said City, the remaining portion of the cost of said improvement of said Broadalbin Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessments heretofore made, ascertained and declared by Ordinance No. 505, passed by the Council of the said City of Albany on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1910 and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1910 on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said Broadalbin Street to be so improved, and especially and particularly benefitted thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City.

The said improvement of said Broadalbin Street shall be completed by the first day of October 1910. All bills for the making of said improvement of said Broadalbin Street deemed unreasonable by the Council of said City may be rejected.

Any firm, corporation or person with which or with whom any contract may be entered into by said City for the making of said improvement, shall, before commencing said improvement,

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and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient security in the sum of \$5000.00 for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, corporation or person entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Broadalm Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, said City shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor during the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

All pavement shall be laid in dry and suitable weather, and not otherwise.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of said Broadalm Street by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Herald, a daily newspaper published daily in said City of Albany, fully describing in such notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Broadalm Street.

Section 4. Inasmuch as there is urgent necessity, and the general welfare of said City demands the immediate improvement of said street, in the manner aforesaid, in order that the same may be completed before the rainy season sets in, an emergency is hereby declared to

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exist, and this ordinance shall be in  
full force and effect from and after  
its passage by said Council and  
its approval by the Mayor of said  
City.
