Section One.

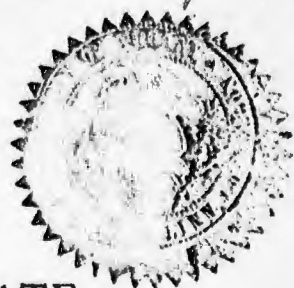
The established grade of Fourth Street between Montgomery and
