

## ORDINANCE No. 570

Relating to proposed amendment to the City Charter authorizing a Deputy Recorder.

Whereas, in the judgment of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, it has become necessary to amend Section 42, Chapter 6, of the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon in 1901, and approved February 16<sup>th</sup> 1901, and amended and added thereto by subsequent Acts, and

Therefore best resolved that the hereinafter proposed amendment to said City Charter be submitted to the people of the City of Albany, Oregon, to be voted upon at the next general election in said City, to be held on Monday, the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1911, which amendment is as follows, to wit:

## A. Bill.

For an act to amend, Section 42, Chapter 6, of an Act to incorporate the City of Albany and to provide a charter therefor and to repeal all Acts and parts of Acts in conflict therewith, passed by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, at the regular session in 1901, and approved by the Governor February 16<sup>th</sup> 1901, as amended and added thereto by subsequent Acts.

Be it enacted by the people of the City of Albany, Oregon,

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows.

Section 1. That Section 42, Chapter 6, of an "Act to incorporate the City of Albany and to provide a Charter therefor and to repeal all acts and parts of Acts in conflict therewith" passed by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, at the regular session in 1901, and approved by the Governor February 16<sup>th</sup> 1901, as amended and added thereto by subsequent Acts, be and the same is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

Section 42, The Recorder is the judicial officer of the Corporation and shall hold a court therein at such place as the Council shall provide, which shall be known as the recorder's Court, and he shall be elected and hold his office as in this act hereinbefore provided.

He is also ex-officio clerk of the Council, and with him must be filed all claims and accounts against the city. He shall keep accurate minutes of all the proceedings of the Council and correct record of judicial business by him transacted.

It is his duty also to file every paper presented to

him officially and take charge of and safely keep all the papers and records of the Corporation.

He may have a deputy to be appointed by such recorder in writing and to continue during the pleasure of the recorder. Such deputy shall have the power to perform any act or duty relating to the recorder's office, except judicial acts, that his principal has, and the recorder is responsible for such deputy's conduct.

Before entering upon his duties, such deputy recorder shall take and subscribe an oath substantially as the oath required of the recorder. He shall receive such compensation for his services as the Council may determine.
