

## Declaring a Surplus - paving Elsworth Street.

Ord 552

An Ordinance declaring a surplus on account of street paving by the Warren Construction Company, a surplus on Elsworth Street, from Third to Ninth Streets, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany, to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said Elsworth street, and heretofore assessed for making such improvement, and entered upon the Docket of City Liens of the City of Albany, Oregon, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows

Section 1. That a surplus of ten and eight tenths per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, and the Warren Construction Company, for the improvement of Elsworth street, from the North curb line of Third street, to the North curb line of Ninth street, and in favor of each of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said street, and heretofore assessed for making such improvement or their several interests may appear.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the docket of City Liens, in the surplus column thereof, a credit of ten and eight tenths per cent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein, to defray the cost of the improvement of said portion of said Elsworth street; said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners of such various parcels of real estate in sums as follows, to-wit: -
